Annual business meeting

The annual business meeting was held on May 3. John Thomas was elected president and Dave Stone was elected vice president.

A majority of the members present at the business meeting wanted a return to an average of two meetings a month from September through May and no meetings during the summer although there will be two outings.

Revisions to the constitution and competition guidelines were discussed and approved with revisions. The most notable change was in the definition of photorealistic. Please note that the *non-photorealistic* categories will now be called **open** categories.

In the **open** competition categories the images do not need to be photo-realistic (i.e., unlimited amount of image processing allowed including special-effect filters).

Photo-realistic images are those that appear to have been captured in a single exposure (blending of images such as HDR, extended depth of field for max sharpness, etc are acceptable). Most other image editing techniques are permitted. Special-effect filters are NOT permitted. Club competition categories are photo-realistic unless they are noted as open. Please find the guidelines on the club's website after August 1.

Members will be limited to three entries per digital category for club competitions.


